

FACE MASK POLICY

Summer Camp 2020

CURRENT FACE MASK POLICY INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING

- Camper Drop Off & Pick Up**
- Campers and Staff inside the Nurse's Station**
- Inside Buildings for a prolonged period of time**
- Visiting the Camp Office**
- Staff Arrival**
- Staff working at the Camp Store**
- Staff applying bug spray or sunscreen on a camper**

****These policies will be in place regardless of age.**

ADDITIONAL FACE MASK REQUIREMENTS

In order to comply with the mandated face mask policy we will now be requiring campers and staff to wear masks at the following times.

Per the Governor's order this does not apply to those younger than 10-years-old (9 & under) or any other minor who cannot safely wear a face covering.

Campers/staff **WILL BE** required to wear masks at:

- Archery
- Nature
- Horseback riding prior to mounting & upon dismounting their horse.
- Inside buildings at anytime
- Arts n' Crafts
- Farmstead Classroom
- Shopping at the camp store

As always, Hiram House will continue to practice social distancing. If temperatures exceed 90 degrees outside, we will not require campers to wear a mask due to the extreme heat.

Campers/staff **will not** be required to wear masks at:

- Low ropes**
- Swimming**
- Hiking or walking to an activity**
- Game playing (basketball, kickball, etc.)**
- Canoeing**
- Lunch time

****These activities are considered physical activity and masks do not have to be worn but social distancing is practiced**

We ask that all Campers and Staff bring a mask with them daily.
