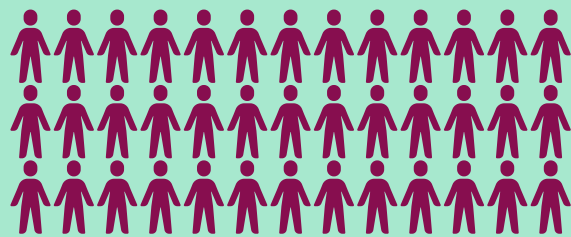
OVERNIGHT SUMMER CAMP

COVID-19 TESTING

NEGATIVE TEST

72 hours prior to the first day of overnight camp, we ask that all campers have a **NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST**. Please bring verification with you on the first day of camp.

ALL CAMPERS



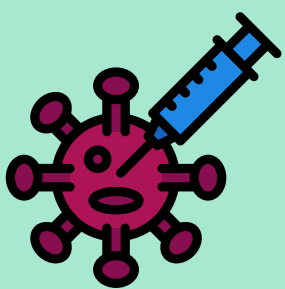
PREP AT HOME



14 DAYS

We will be sending home a self-assessment sheet to track temperatures and symptoms prior to camp. We ask that all families make appropriate choices in the 2 weeks leading to the start of camp to ensure the safety of all campers and staff.

COVID-19 VACCINE



We will be keeping up with the latest information from the CDC on the distribution of the COVID-19 vaccine to minors. If the approval comes prior to camp we strongly recommend that all campers are vaccinated.

We are also strongly recommending that our staff become vaccinated prior to the start of camp.

MASK UP HIRAM HOUSE



We ask that all campers continue to wear their face masks when out and about prior to the start of camp.

During camp, face masks will be required at all times except eating, sleeping, swimming and at high ropes.

OUR COMMITMENT TO YOU

Hiram House will be following all CDC and American Camp Association guidelines for cleaning and disinfection. Daily activities, bathrooms and high touch surfaces will be cleaned multiple times throughout the day. All Camp Staff will be trained on cleaning and disinfection as well as a general Covid-19 guidelines.
